AINE (pronounced "An-yeh") was formed in 2007 initially as an all-female ensemble but later added male voices. The group performs almost exclusively the compositions and arrangements of **Alexander Douglas**, whose unique approach to contemporary gospel music adopts elements from both jazz and classical music. As noted, the group reached the final of the prestigious **BBC Songs of Praise Gospel Choir of the Year 2014** competition.

ALEXANDER DOUGLAS

Alex is Conductor of The Huddersfield Singers, Music Director of AINE and director of various other ensembles. Beyond his gospel interests he is a great proponent of the music of Bach, and has wide-ranging interests in classical music and jazz. He has achieved success as a composer and arranger, including having written a film score that was performed by Hugh Laurie! He holds three Masters degrees in music.
